Timber Harvest Plan Summaries

1-07-161 Hum- LE 51

This Scotia Pacific THP which includes 68.9 acres of clearcuts is adjacent to Stitz Creek, approximately 2.5 miles SE to 3.5 miles E of Scotia. The THP includes Late Seral Forest, and Class 'D' marbled murrelet habitat. This THP is currently being held up because the forester has not submitted a response to the PHI.

1-07-163 Hum- Lower Pilot Creek 'Last Chance' THP

This Green Diamond plan in the Lower Pilot Creek proposes 11 acres of clearcuts approximately 14 miles W of the town of Mad River. The plan claims no late successional forests are proposed for logging, however Google Earth shows decadent trees. The area is possibly un-entered. Also Trinity Bristle Snails have been found in the area.

1-07-170 Hum- #44-0701 Canyon Creek

This Green Diamond THP includes 89.5 acres of clearcuts in second growth forest 7 miles NE of Blue Lake. Ground based equipment will be used on unstable soils or slide areas. This THP includes winter ops and construction of roads and landings. There are other landowners within 1000 feet downstream of the THP boundary. There is habitat present for southern torrent salamander, tailed frog, Del Norte salamander, and Northern spotted owl among other wildlife species.

1-07-171 Hum- #47-0703 Maple Creek

This Green Diamond THP includes 148.6 acres of clearcuts in second growth forest and is located approximately 7.5 miles NE of Trinidad. The THP includes winter ops and road and landing construction. Steep streamside slopes and Class I watercourses are found within this THP. Southern Torrent salamander, tailed frog, steelhead, coastal cutthroat trout, have been observed within the THP which additionally provides habitat for foothill yellow-legged and Northern red-legged frogs, peregrine falcon and Northern spotted owl.

1-07-195 Hum- # 04-0703

This Green Diamond THP includes 29 acres of clearcut forestry approximately 7 miles . The THP area includes unstable soils or slide areas and winter operations. The THP includes new road and landing construction, including logging roads proposed unstable soils or known slide prone areas. The logging is within 1000 feet upstream of USFS land in the Lower Trinity Ranger District. NSO habitat is found within the plan, however NSO

have not been sighted within the plan. No late successional forests are included in the THP.

1-07-201 Hum- #43-0705

This Green Diamond THP includes 51 acres of clearcut forestry 650 ft. E of Lower South Fork Little River approximately 1.5 miles NE of Fieldbrook Grange. A slide area in Unit A is called 'Slide C.' The RPF proposes to clearcut a 7 acre area surrounding the slide, and cable yarding trees to the upper road. Unit A also includes possible debris slide slopes on the west and south west flanks of Tip Top Ridge. Unit B includes a feature noted as 'G-5' and described as a 'large scale dormant earthflow, observed in 1941 air photos. This THP includes winter operations and new road and landing construction. There are other landowners within 1000 feet downstream, including 4 domestic water intakes located downslope of CR2250 road south of Unit A, The water course with the domestic water intakes does not drain from the THP but is located 160 feet down slope from the appurtenant truck road. Some NSO habitat is included in the plan, however there are no occurrences of NSO. No late successional forests are included in this THP.

1-07-202 Del- #85-0701

This Green Diamond THP includes 109 acres of clearcut forestry adjacent to the Klamath River approximately 4.5 miles SE of Klamath Glen. The Erosion Hazard Rating for this THP is moderate to high. There are 6 noted slides or unstable areas within the THP. One unstable area includes a failed road. The THP proposes 25 foot no harvest zones beyond the areas influenced by slides/ unstable areas. The THP proposes winter operations and new road and landing construction. This plan contains steep streamside slopes. There are other landowners within 1000 ft downstream. Southern torrent salamander and Del Norte Salamanders have been observed in the THP, as well as four species of anadromous fish. There is no late successional forest associated with this THP.

1-07-203 Del- #

This Green Diamond THP includes 53 acres of clearcuts adjacent to Waukell Creek, approximately 3 mi S of Klamath. The THP proposes winter operations and the construction of new roads and landings. There are other landowners within 1000 feet downstream. Coastal cutthroat trout have been observed in the plan area. There are no late succession forests associated with this plan.

1-07-204 Hum- Root 09 THP

This Scotia Pacific THP is located 1.25 miles west of the community of Swains Flat, and 2.5 miles NE of Holmes, directly adjacent to Root Creek which is a tributary into the Van Duzen River. The THP includes 61.2 acres of clearcuts, 93.2 acres of shelterwood preparatory step cuts, and 18 acres of select cuts. There are no Late Successional or Late Seral Forest stands proposed for harvest. There is 1 level 2 spotted owl territory within 500 feet of an appurtenant road, and there are three level 1 spotted owl territories within a

1.5 miles of the THP, and seven level 2 & 3 spotted owl territories within 1.5 miles of the THP.

1-07-206 Hum- #14-0701

This Green Diamond THP is approximately 3 miles east of Loleta adjacent to the Middle Salmon Creek. The THP proposes 109.5 acres of clearcut forestry. This plan contains Steep Streamside Slopes, as well as new road and landing construction. Three anadromous fish have been observed in the THP. The THP includes some NSO habitat. There are no Late Successional Forests proposed for harvest as part of this THP.

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1-08-001 Hum- Looped THP

This Scotia Pacific THP is located approximately 4 miles east of Weott, and Bell Creek, Bloyd Creek, McCann Creek, and Devil's Elbow Creek run through it. The THP includes 24 acres of clearcuts. The Erosion Hazard Rating for this THP includes low, moderate and high ratings, as well as unstable soils or slide areas. Winter operations, new road and landing construction, as well as directional felling of trees away within WLPZs are planned for this THP. There are landowners within 1000 feet downstream of the THP boundary. There are no Late Successional Forest or Late Seral Forest Stands proposed for harvest as part of this plan.

1-08-002 Hum- LE 59 THP

This Scotia Pacific THP is approximately 1 mile west of Rio Dell, adjacent to Nanning Creek, Tank Gulch and the Eel River. The THP proposes 15 acres of clearcuts, 47 acres of Shelterwood Preparatory cuts, 23 acres of Shelterwood Removal Step cuts, and 178.5 acres of Selection cuts. The THP includes winter operations, new road and landing construction, directional felling of trees in WLPZs, and landowners within 1000 feet downstream from proposed logging operations. There is one Level 1 NSO territory within 500 feet of proposed logging, as well as 9 other Level 1-3 NSO sites within 1.5 miles of the THP. This plan includes a release of 20.2 acres of 'C' and 'D' murrelet habitat by USFWS. Also there is an occupied osprey nest tree within the harvest boundary of Unit 2. There are also 2 Peregrine Falcon sites within .5 miles of this THP. There is also a red-shouldered hawk nest site located south of Unit 2. There is Late Seral Forest proposed for harvesting as part of this THP.

1-08-003 Hum- Panhandle 08 THP

This Scotia Pacific THP is approximately 1.5 miles SW of Hacketsville, California, adjacent to Howe Creek and tributaries of Howe creek which flow to the Eel River. The THP includes 53 acres of clearcuts, and 10 acres of selection cuts. The THP proposes winter operations, new road and landing construction, and directional felling of trees in WLPZs. There are other landowners within 1000 feet downstream of proposed logging operations. There are three NSO territories within 1.3 miles of the harvest area including

1 Level 2 territory within 500 m. There are no Late Successional or Late Seral Forest stands planned for harvest as a part of this THP.

1-08-004 Hum- #545

This Green Diamond THP is located in the Bald Hills area and is approximately 9 miles E-SE of Orick, and 6.5 miles S of Johnson. The plan proposes 61 acres of clearcuts. There are 5 property owners within 300 feet adjacent to the plan, which use the area for domestic water source. The Erosion Hazard Rating for the area includes both moderate and high ratings. Winter operations, new road and landing construction are all proposed for this THP. This THP does not propose to harvest Late Successional Forest. The THP area may be occupied by NSO and golden eagle.

1-08-006 Hum- #06-0701

This GDRCo THP is approximately 1 mile W of Rio Dell, approximately 1500 feet S of the Eel River, adjacent to Slater Creek. The THP proposes 84 acres of clearcuts, 14.5 acres of select cuts in the WLPZ, and 18.5 acres of select cuts in unstable areas. There are other landowners within 1000 feet downstream. NSO and steelhead have been observed in the THP. This THP does not propose to harvest Late Succession Forest Stands.

1-08-007 Del -

This GDRCo THP is adjacent to Lopez Creek and Ritmer Creek, and is approximately 1 mile N of the town of Smith River. The THP proposes 77 acres of clearcuts, winter operations, and new road and landing construction. There are other landowners within 1000 feet downstream. The THP contains habitat for NSO and Coho salmon, but does not propose to harvest Late Succession Forest Stands.

1-08-008 Hum – Rail Car THP

This Scotia Pacific THP is approximately 2 miles NE of the community of Myers Flat, and approximately 1 mile W of Fruitland, and Bridge Creek runs through it. The THP proposes 150 acres of clearcuts, winter operations, new landing construction, and directional felling of trees in WLPZs. There are other landowners within 1000 feet downstream, and domestic water sources in the vicinity. There is a Level 1 NSO territory within 500 feet of the logging area. There is a NSO nest tree in unit 8. This THP proposes to harvest Late Seral Forest. There are also known archeological or historical sites within the THP.

1-08-010 Hum - #43-0707

This Green Diamond THP is in the headwaters of Little River. There are various anadromous fish that occupy this stream. There is no Late Seral / Late Successional forest proposed for harvest. There is an archeological or historical site.

1-08-012 Men- Seven Mile Snake THP

This Coastal Ridges LLC THP does not include clearcuts. There are other landowners within 1000 feet. The forester or designee will conduct NSO surveys prior to harvest. Surveys have not been conducted for any protected species. If protected species are discovered during logging operations, than they will be protected, if it is not already too late. This THP does not propose the harvest of Late Successional Forest.
